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Assoc. Prof. Gary Antonio C. Lirio leads the Center for Life Sciences Research under the Research Institute for Science and Technology at the Polytechnic University of the Philippines. His research work focuses on microbial resources, particularly in the isolation, characterization, and application of microorganisms for environmental and biotechnological purposes. He has been actively engaged in discussions and training related to export control and dual-use research. He participated in the Strategic Trade Management Awareness Forum for Philippine Academia held on March 19, 2024, at Sofitel Philippine Plaza Manila, and in the Workshop on Enhancing the Protection and Control of Emerging Dual-Use Technologies conducted on August 5–8, 2024, in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, sponsored by the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL).
